The Anesthesia department is a diverse and vibrant group who pride themselves on fostering a supportive and collegial environment. The team provides services to the obstetrical unit and surgical programs in orthopedics, ENT, urology, endoscopy, and maxillofacial surgery. The scope of practice provides mainly adult care with some pediatric anesthesiology. Our surgeons perform approximately 8,000 procedures each year.

Anesthesiologists have the opportunity to teach medical students and residents through an affiliation with Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry at Western University and there are opportunities for an academic appointment.

Anesthesiologists must participate in on-call rotation. Candidates must be eligible for independent practice licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, and hold FRCPC certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Anesthesiology.
