

St Thomas Elgin General Hospital Emergency Medicine - Full Time/Part Time Positions

St Thomas Elgin General Hospital (STEGH) is a 157 bed community hospital with a high-volume Emergency Department (ED) and a full complement of acute in-patient care services in addition to complex medical management, stroke inpatient rehabilitation, and acute palliation. We are seeking full and part time CCFP (EM) or FRCP applicants to join our active and growing team. STEGH has very collegial, high functioning emergency medicine group. Our Emergency Department has been at or near the top of provincial efficiency metrics for several years.

The City of St. Thomas (population 40,000) is located 15 minutes south of London, Ontario and 10 minutes from the shores of Lake Erie. STEGH serves a local community of 40, 000 and eight municipalities within Elgin County.

Emergency Medicine Practice Profile

- Alternate Funding Arrangement with shadow FFS billing
- 8 shifts, with 62h coverage in a 24h day. Six shifts cover the acute/subacute presentations with two shifts dedicated to lower acuity care.
- 23 room department with 2 clinically designated trauma rooms, two negative pressure rooms, two mental health rooms, and a dedicated ophthalmology room.
- Clinical support includes ICU, Internal medicine and hospitalist programs, in-patient psychiatry (Schedule 1 facility), paediatrics (Level 2a nursery) and obstetrics.
- 1hr admit to in-patient bed policy to prevent prolonged boarding in ER
- Local RAAM support with in-house CMHA support
- Participate in Resident teaching through Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry, Western University.

Volume of Service

- 56,000 visits annually
- 5,800 Admissions per year (10-11%)
- CTAS breakdown: CATS 1: 2%, CTAS 2: 21%. CTAS 3: 46%, CTAS 4: 24%, CTAS 5: 8%
- 16 Bed ICU with 8 level III beds
- Established in-hospital urgent CAD, CHF, TIA, Rheumatology, Respirology, Gastroenterology, Diabetes, GIM, orthopaedics and general surgery clinics.
- Additional local specialist support includes urology, ophthalmology and ENT.
- CT with contrast studies with 24/7 Radiology support.
- U/S 7 days a week with dedicated ER bookings
- MRI (2022 planned installation)
- STEMI (PCI) and Stroke (Lysis and EVT) support 15 mins away at LHSC (London Health Sciences Center)
- Multi-system Trauma support, 15 mins away at LHSC

For CCFP licensed applicants, there are opportunities to compliment ED work within community family medicine, in-patient hospitalist medicine or GP-oncology.
