The Department of Paediatrics at St. Thomas Elgin General Hospital (STEGH) is seeking a dynamic individual to join our Department full-time. St. Thomas Elgin General Hospital is a fully accredited 157-bed facility providing comprehensive 24 hour coverage in Internal Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics, Paediatrics, Anaesthesia, Emergency, Mental Health, and Family Medicine. We are proud to serve the City of St. Thomas and all eight municipalities within the County of Elgin.

We are a group of Community Consultant Paediatricians who support our local secondary level hospital. We cover a six bed Paediatric ward, 4 bed level 2a NICU and newborns, approximately 700 a year. We support the Labour & Delivery and Emergency Department when on call and have a strong ER Department with whom we work well with. Call is one in five, 1 week at a time. In the community, we do a combination of consultant and primary Paediatrics.

Candidates must hold an MD or equivalent and be eligible for licensure in the Province of Ontario with certification in Paediatrics from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or equivalent. The applicant will have a willingness to work in a dynamic team-based environment. Potential candidates would have the opportunity to help further continue the development of the Paediatric Program at STEGH. They would also collaborate with primary care, and participate in education and capacity building with community care partners. The desired candidate will have the skills and expertise to contribute to a culture of continuous learning and education, along with evidence of impact in clinical innovation.

As a community training site, the St. Thomas Elgin General Hospital participates in the Southwestern Ontario Medical Education Network, providing educational opportunities for medical students and residents, and is affiliated with the University of Western Ontario. We are involved in the training of medical students, residents, Nurse Practitioners, and Physician Assistant Students. There is the opportunity to be associated with Western University and our Regional Tertiary Children's Hospital.
